Shabat Study by Yada, January 6, 2023

Good evening and Happy Shabat. Welcome to Yada Yah. For those who have not seen it, I would encourage you to go to the yadayah.com homepage to view the beautifully animated primary symbol Yahowah has chosen to convey His message to us, the Manowrah. Its luminaries are coordinated with each of His seven Mow'ed Miqra'ey. You will also see that the volume that we had posted as Volume 9 of the *Yada Yahowah* series has been moved on the bookshelf and is now Volume 1 of the two-volume set entitled *Babel*. These are now located on the bookshelf between the *Coming Home* and *Questioning Paul* series. There is an interim of what I have written thus far for Ezekiel that David has posted. Thank you, David.

For those who want to catch up on why we have concluded that Ezekiel is a false prophet and that the Lord of Babylon is actually Satan, I would encourage you to read that. There are two or three chapters that are really tough sledding; they are graphic, sadistic and one where the Lord of Babel is fixated on boiling Jews alive. It's important because Ezekiel is the one book that has been embraced by the three major religions, Christianity, Islam and Judaism. It plays a very big role in the *Talmud* and *Zohar* and has a huge influence over the mistreatment of women in Judaism and in Christianity it's quoted vociferously in Revelation. What we read is the Lord's animosity towards Jews and it is the prevailing theme throughout Paul's letters and the so-called "Gospels." Ezekiel is the one book that makes prolific entry into the *Quran* because the rabbis were fascinated with it and they shared their stories with Muhammad, and he found Gog and Magog to be interesting. It has been posted; the work is far from done. I'm only in the 27th chapter, but you can read the first nine chapters of the second volume on Ezekiel of the *Babel* series which are now available on the bookshelf.

The last thing I did which, is not yet on the website, was a review of the prophecies on Tyre which makes up the 26th chapter of Ezekiel. It says probably 50 or more specific things about Tyre, and not a single one is accurate. It's not possible to make 50 statements about a city like Tyre and have every statement be false unless it's deliberate: it's just not. So, I concluded that every single statement that Ezekiel's Lord makes about Tyre is false because he is playing the same tune which is trying to tell Yahowah that people are so stupid they will believe a pile of lies over You, so why in the world are You so interested in saving these idiots who I can fool with the most absurd lies? It's just pathetic.

There are some items in the news. I've been saying this now for the better part of 10 to 12 years that the United States deliberately and knowingly set a course for war between itself and Russia using the Ukraine as a backdrop. I've been saying this since we instigated the riots in the Ukraine in, I think 2013 - 2014, to prevail in switching Ukraine's financial dependence, because it's a one of the world's worst graft-oriented countries, from Russia which could afford underpinning the Ukraine because they had pipelines where they could make certain that those loans were repaid to switching it to the international monetary fund, and I spoke vociferously about what that was going to mean. But that was only a few billion dollars a year and now we're squandering 100 billion dollars a year turning Ukraine into a war zone. I predicted what it was going to eventually lead to and talked about how the ultimate goal was to make Ukraine part of Warsaw which Russia would respond to. It'd be like the Cuban Missile Crisis but this time we didn't have wiser heads and so the world would be embarked upon a nuclear war.

Well Medvedev, who was the previous leader of Russia and Putin's ally, announced this week that their hypersonic cruise missiles are fully deployable and that the intent is to arm them with nuclear warheads and put them on Russian ships in international waters off the coast of Washington D.C., and there's nothing the United States can do to stop them. At the rate of Russian losses to US-made military hardware in Ukraine it's only a matter of time. So, I want our listeners to know that the United States is responsible for this war and that we are going to pay a very dear price for it. It's not just on the crumbling of our economy, it's not just that we're going to lose our reserve currency status through the BRIC process because of the way that we have tried to control the world and sanction Russia, it's not just through the food shortages and the oil price increases and rampant inflation that this has all caused, it's not just the death toll of America arming the Ukraine in a proxy war, it's not just the death of truth which the United States has orchestrated through deliberate propaganda and the silencing of opposing voices, it's going to be millions.

Speaking of people dying, Lapid, who I really dislike, told Netanyahu that by allowing one of his ministers who had a regular practice of taking walks on the Temple Mount (which last time I checked was a Jewish property) that by allowing him to do that that people were going to die. The United States and even the United Nations condemned Israel for allowing one of the ministers in the Netanyahu government to walk on the Temple Mount. His crime was that he as a Jew took a walk on the Temple Mount. The Muslim world was having a conniption fit of course.

One of the things I just do not understand, it has perplexed me since I wrote Prophet of Doom, is that claiming Jerusalem and the Temple Mount, the Dome of the hoofy Print al-Aqsa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock as Islam's third holiest site is a complete and utter embarrassment to Islam and I've just never understood why Jews are incapable of just coming out and saying it's all a farce shoving it in the Progressive faces, shoving it in the face of the United Nations. Tell the truth, damn it. They claim it because when Muhammad was in Petra (not in Mecca) claimed that while he was in bed with Aisha who was nine years old at the time and he was 53 (that's pedophilia) imagined because of the Satanic Verses where he admitted that all of Allah's Messengers speak on behalf of Satan, that when he claimed that there were many gods that would lead to Allah they mocked him and he needed an escape. So, he imagined in his sleep that night that he jumped upon a winged ass and flew to Jerusalem to visit the Temple and all the Jewish big shots of history. Of course, Muhammad lived at the end of the of the 7th century and the Temple had been destroyed by Hadrian and the Romans at the beginning of the 2nd century; it didn't even exist. Wild asses don't exist, donkeys do not fly, pedophiles do not get entry into these kinds of discussions. And, of course, even when he got there, when the Dome of the Rock is the place where the wild ass then left with Muhammad on it, to the Islamic heaven, in route to the Islamic heaven, guess what. Hell comes first. He announced that its inhabitants were all women hanging by meat hooks through their breasts because they didn't appreciate the abuse that men were giving to them. And of course, in Islam obviously since Muhammad never made it to Heaven any other way, the only way you can get there is through Jerusalem. It is a pathetic story that embarrasses Muhammad, that embarrasses Muslims, that proves that the whole Quran is false, that the claims on the Temple Mount are a total and complete embarrassment to the religion. It's obvious and it's undeniable. Why is it the Jews can't tell the truth and say this is ridiculous? But no, they would rather try to appease the world and pretend that one of their own can't walk on the Temple Mount.

Speaking of stupid, the head of NASA is saying that we need to hurry to the moon because if we don't the Chinese are going to land a spacecraft and claim the moon as their territory. Good grief! People believe this stuff? What in the heck is wrong with us?

Do you know that Israel has the fourth most powerful military in the world? After the United States, whose military and spying mechanism is larger than the rest of the world's combined, China and Russia and then comes Israel. Now they don't spend the fourth most on it, but they have the fourth most powerful military in the world and all they're trying to do is stay alive.

There's a picture circulating of Pope Benedict, who crapped out this past week, kissing this little plastic Jesus doll (halo included) that somebody would put in their Christmas manger. The Poopster's last words were just hilarious. He says, "Oh I love you, Lord!" He doesn't even know that the Lord is Satan, but I'm not sure that the Lord loves him back either. It is a crazy world.

The UN voted this week to have an international hearing in Hague on the occupation of its own country. It's amazing they don't have a hearing on the US occupying Texas or California. I think we should give California back to the Mexicans. No, they don't want to do that, but they do want to hold the Jews accountable for their occupation and their treatment of the Fakestinians, not that any of them are smart enough to know that the last of the Fakestinians (the Philistines) were killed by the Assyrians. There's some rumor that Alexander may have tangled with a remnant of them in 330 - some odd BCE.

I didn't know this but almost everything we know about Alexander was written 450 years after his death by Arrian, a Greco-Roman leader and a big fan and friend of Hadrian, one of God's least favorite people. So, we don't really have much of a contemporary resource in that regard. But nonetheless he would claim that there was a skirmish with the last outpost of the Fakestinians. Let's just say they survived the Assyrian assault around 720 BCE. There was nothing left of them by the time Alexander finished with the last outpost and therefore there are no Palestinians and there's no place called Palestine. It is a complete and utter force, and it should be declared as such.

Most of you know that I live on an island in the Caribbean with about 85 to 90 percent black in terms of its ethnicity, about five to seven percent Caucasian and the rest mostly Hispanic. They've been celebrating their second Christmas these past few days which is nothing but a street orgy. They might as well just throw beds in the street and screw one another. It's an interesting thing because some of my friends who have not been here very long go down there just to observe the decadence of the whole thing and as a white face, as one of a thousand that are there, a black woman will come up to him and say, "How dare you!" They will curse them for no

other reason than being white and you want to say, "You know if you think that life isn't good for you here who do you have to blame? All 18 senators are black, the governor and lieutenant governor are black, all the judges are black all the prosecutors, everybody is black. There isn't anybody in government that isn't black so why are you blaming the five or seven percent that are Caucasian particularly since they hire lots of people? If you want a hundred percent black go to Haiti; see how things are working out for the Haitians. Tens of thousands of them have been gunned down this year; nothing but armed gangs with guns rule that Island."

Do you know that life expectancy in the United States has actually fallen for the first time in almost forever? Yeah, we're not living as long.

The Trumpster is all upset now that the Republicans don't love him as much as they used to, and his new threat is that if they don't nominate him he's going to run as a third party candidate. That ought to work out really well for everybody. Wouldn't it? It is a scary place.

Lastly, it was the end of last week or the first part of this week that Pope Francis, who is now sporting a wheeled chariot just like the Lord in Ezekiel, his has at least four wheels although there are wheels inside of the wheels. He's romping around in a wheelchair trying to mimic the god of Ezekiel. He announced that there's an "elegant demon" that lurks among the Vatican staff. Not just to your average demon - no, an "elegant demon." I thought that was particularly interesting.

With that review of the news let's return to Howsha' which is news for the day. Howsha' is reaching out to Yahowah's people, Yisra'el and Yahuwdym, the plural of Yahuwdah / Jews. Yisra'el would represent ten of the 12 tribes that are not comprised of Yahuwdah and of Benyamyn; I'm not sure there's going to be a lot of Benyamynites that are going to be part of the reunion during Kipurym. They have a pretty bad history with Yahowah and the rest of the of the crew, but there will be lots of Yahuwdym / Jews and also a recovery of a remnant of Yisra'elites. So, the book of Howsha' is saying that about circa 750 BCE your religion has made it impossible for Me to continue to have a relationship with you and so we're going to have a long time out and during that long time I'm not going to communicate with you. I will reveal the message through a few more prophets from Yahuwdah, but we are done. And it was shortly thereafter that the Assyrians made certain of that. But then with Yahuwdah it says there will be a little more time there to try to communicate and to save My people and He would communicate through Yirma'yah, Zakaryah and Malaky over the next 300 years and then it was radio silence. From 450 BCE to today God has not spoken through a prophet and there's not going to be another prophet until Dowd / David returns.

While He speaks of this time of separation, of a divorce and estrangement, He also speaks of coming back together and of the reunion on Yom Kipurym, the Day of Reconciliations, in year 6000 Yah which is 2033.

So, here's the passage we ended with last week:

"Therefore (*wa*), you will stumble and fall (*kashal* – you will stagger, be brought down and overthrown, fail) by day (*ha yowm*), and the prophet, also (*wa naby*' gam – the one who claims to speak for God likewise), will waver and falter, becoming injurious (*kashal* – will be overthrown) along with you (*'im 'atah*) at night (*laylah* – during the darkness). Then (*wa*) I will make this comparable to (*damah* – I will cause this to silence and resemble) your mother (*'em 'atah*)." (*Howsha'* / He Saves / Hosea 4:5)

God's problem with His people is their religion. It is the issue which continues to separate man from God. He made that very clear:

you will stumble and fall (*kashal* – you will stagger, be brought down and overthrown, fail) **by day** (*ha yowm*), **along with the prophet, also** (*wa naby' gam* – the one who claims to speak for God likewise), **will waver and falter, becoming injurious** (*kashal* – will be overthrown) **along with you** (*'im 'atah*) **at night** (*laylah* – during the darkness).

The problem is religion. It is what has misled Jews, taking them away from God.

Since the people were as corrupt as their clerics, God told the Yisra'elites, and us through them, that no one was in a position to point fingers. The destiny of the deceived would be the same as that of those who had deceived them, at least in the sense that they would both stumble and fall.

In this context – especially in the midst of Yahowah's overt condemnation of Judaism, I think that this next statement is among the most important ever written.

"My people ('*am* '*any*) – This would be Yisra'el inclusive of Yahuwdah **are destroyed and they will perish** (*damah* – they are ruined and will cease to exist, having become the brunt of a sad story (nifal perfect – the people have destroyed themselves and will suffer the consequence for a protracted, but limited, period of time for what they have done which is destructive and ruinous))

In the nifal stem the subject both carries out and suffers the effect of the verb. The verb is "destruction and perish." So, they are destroying themselves and as a result

they are going to receive the brunt of that and cease to exist. The perfect means that this happened during a period of time; that period of time could be 2,000 years but it is not forever which means there will be a time that they ceased to be self-destructive.

My people ('am 'any) are destroyed and they will perish (damah - they are ruined and will cease to exist, having become the brunt of a sad story (nifal perfect – the people have destroyed themselves and will suffer the consequence for a protracted, but limited, period of time for what they have done which is destructive and ruinous)) because of (min – from) a lack of understanding as a result of corrupted information

Bely means "to deprive oneself of," "to lack something," "for something to be inadequate." *Da'at* means "empirical knowledge." (*Bely ha da'at* – being without adequate knowledge, having insufficient awareness, and deficient discernment, lacking the will to recall what is important and the capacity to rationally analyze the data to comprehend it (infinitive substantive – being ignorant and irrational regarding these prophetic revelations has come to demonstrably and vividly define Yisra'elites over the long chasm of time)).

This is because (ky - for the express reason that) you (*'atah*) have avoided and rejected (*ma'as* – you have spurned and despised, refused and disdained, showing an aversion to (qal perfect – revealing that the avoidance was complete and the rejection was literal)) the process which leads to understanding (*ha da'at* – the knowledge required to comprehend, the information which enables discernment).

Most people don't have a clue what that means. They think they were separated from God and that God says they were doing something that was self-destructive because they were practicing a false religion, because they didn't have the proper faith, because they were engaged in fornication, improper sexual behavior, were cheating on their spouses, so it must be adultery. No.

God says the problem is that you lack understanding, that specifically empirical knowledge, the truth, having access to and processing the evidence in a rational way is what is causing this problem. It is because you lack understanding. You do not have adequate knowledge; you have insufficient awareness.

The problem wasn't they didn't believe or their faith. The problem was their thinking. Evidence and reason are the only tools we have to come to know and to engage in a relationship with Yahowah; evidence and reason, knowledge which leads to understanding, rationally analyzing the data so that we comprehend it.

KIRK: I looked *da'at* up just out of interest. It's an interesting thing for understanding, knowledge, wisdom, discernment. You have to go through this. It's a dalet, ayn and taw so I would suggest that you can't get through the Pesach door. Your perspective is wrong and that would lead you _____ the signposts along the way _____ so the first one if you don't know how to find it what, he's saying pictographically I think, is you don't know where the Pesach Door is, you don't know pathway home.

YADA: If you are celebrating a seder meal and you've got a plate full of vegetables with a bone on the middle of then you're as lost as was Qayn and you've got no concept as to what the purpose is of the Passover Lamb, you have no idea as to why Matsah is an essential part of Pesach and why ultimately Chag Matsah is the celebration of which Pesach is a part. If you don't understand those things, you're not going to live. God's issue is that you're not only not thinking you're not even processing the information that I've made available to you. This is because for the express reason that you have avoided and rejected / ma'as. You have spurned and despised, refused and disdained, showing an aversion to da'at / the process which leads to understanding.

The second most valuable thing in the universe is knowledge. The most powerful and most valuable thing in the universe is understanding. You won't hear that anyplace else. They will tell you that love is the most important thing in the universe; no, it's not. They'll tell you religion, faith, freedom, patriotism, valor tolerance, or some other such nonsense. No. According to God the second most important thing in the universe is knowledge; the most important is understanding.

So, God's people according to Yahowah, Who's in a position to know, are destroyed and they will perish because they lack understanding as the result of corrupted information and this is because they have avoided and rejected the process which leads to understanding; they've chosen religion instead.

Therefore (wa – so then), **I will consistently reject you and avoid you** (ma'as 'atah – I will actually disassociate from you and will rebuff you, coming to despise and loathe you as vile, showing an aversion to you, spurning you (qal imperfect)) **from serving as priests and ministers** (min kahan – from acting as counselors and clerics, working as teachers or facilitators (piel infinitive – this decision to curtail the priestly service is being imposed upon Yisra'el by Yahowah, emphatically, demonstrably, and continually)) **on My behalf** (la 'any – for Me or to approach Me).

Why? Because you don't know what you are doing. The priests, and now rabbis, could no more direct a Jew to knowledge of Yahowah's name than a man on the moon. There isn't one of them who understands the purpose of the Mow'ed

Miqra'ey, that can articulate the Five Conditions of the Covenant or even the Five Benefits: not one. If you don't know the value of Yahowah's name, if you don't know the conditions of the Covenant, or understand the benefits of the Covenant, if you don't understand the integration of those seven Mow'ed Miqra'ey, the Invitations to meet with God and how they pertain to receiving the benefits of the Covenant becoming part of God's family, then there is no hope. Not one with all their ugly grey beards, with their big fancy speeches and hateful rhetoric; they are universally clueless. God is saying, "You are no longer going to serve Me; we're done. I've had enough." And since that time, they haven't.

In fact, if you look at the Maccabean Revolt the Maccabees ostensibly said, "We're getting way too much of the Greek influenza into our culture and our religion." And yet Rabbinic Judaism is hugely Greek in terms of its heritage and origin including the kippah that they wear. In fact, they go to a synagogue; it's a Greek term. This was a war about who is going to be in charge. The old system of the priests explaining what's important or are we going to have ourselves, the precursors to the rabbis, claim authority? It was an armed resurrection against the Greeks, and it really set up the ultimate conflicts that would follow the three invasions of Yahuwdah by the Romans and ultimate and complete destruction of the land and of Jerusalem.

God's saying you're not going to serve on My behalf anymore. When God says that, for Him to be able to communicate His message to His people, somebody else has got to do it and it won't be a Yisra'elite. So, perhaps that's the reason you're listening to a program tonight that is hosted by a Gowy.

And since (*wa*) you have consistently ignored and forgotten, failing to remember or respond to (*shakach* – you have overlooked and lost sight of the significance of, ceasing to care about, and failing to mention (qal imperfect – actually and continually become oblivious to)) the *Towrah* | Teaching and Guidance of your God (*Towrah 'elohym 'atah* – Your God's Towrah Instructions and Directions, Your God's Source of Leadership and Path to Follow, the Almighty's Education; derived from: tow – God's signed, written, and enduring, towrah – way of treating people, tuwr – giving us the means to explore, find, and choose, yarah – the source of instruction, training, supervision, and direction which flows from God, tuwb – providing answers that facilitate our restoration and return, even our reply to that which is towb – good, pleasing, beneficial, and right, and that which causes us to be loved, to become acceptable, and to endure, tahowr – purifying and cleansing us, thereby towr – providing us with the opportunity to change our attitude and thinking toward God), **I also** (*'any gam*) will ignore and forget your children (*shakah ben*

'atah – I will overlook your sons, lose sight of your children, and consider your offspring as worthless (qal imperfect))." (*Howsha'* / He Saves / Hosea 4:6)

The rabbis would say, "Oh no. We don't even have a political party that has Torah in the name. We have Yeshiva, schools, that all we do is study the Torah. We've even forgotten about math and English or any other sciences; no, we just study the Torah." Bull. They claim that their Talmud is Towrah; it's ludicrous, it's a lie. In fact, it's an obvious lie. To believe the lie you have to be stupid. It's the Babylonian Talmud and it is not the Towrah. And so, the reason that Jews and Yahowah aren't on speaking terms is because they have ignored, forgotten and failed to even care about Yahowah's Towrah. If you were to ask a religious Jew what Towrah means every one of them would lie to you; they'd say "law." There is nothing in the word *Towrah* that would suggest law. Yahowah even tells us the basis of *Towrah*. He says that it is based upon *yara'* / source from which teaching, guidance and instruction flow, source of teaching and direction. Teaching is not law; guidance is not law. You don't go to jail for breaking an instruction, no one was ever prison imprisoned for a direction. Towrah means "guidance, teaching, directions, instructions," and that's why he said "the Towrah of your God" as opposed to "the Talmud of your religious creeps."

So, what's the consequence? God is in the role of father. He's saying that My children are ignoring My Towrah teaching and guidance, so it's His only option; I will ignore your children, and He did. There wasn't a single Jew over the course of 2,500 years with whom Yahowah could communicate; no one to listen, no one to share, not one. That's tragic. So, the only option was for Yahowah to reach out through a gentile which is what He has done.

For religions based upon the *Talmud*, *New Testament*, or *Qur'an* to emerge and grow in the shadow of this declaration, the men responsible for promoting them had to be willfully dishonest. Jews carry the book of Howsha' around in their Tanakh. They know it exists, they read from it. How in the world can you be so oblivious to it? In fact, since the prophecies revealed by Howsha' prove Divine inspiration, it is a miracle that anyone believes any religion – when we can and should know and understand.

Some people ask me, "What do you believe?" I don't believe squat. What's the value of believing? If you can know, belief is useless.

You can know; you can know Yahowah. You can understand what He's offering and what He's expecting in return. You can know and understand that the primary thing that separates humankind from God is religion. So, why would you want to believe?

There are few passages as important to God's people as this one. 'Am 'any / my family refers to Yisra'el – these are the descendants of 'Abraham, Yitschaq, and Ya'aqob.

Now, there are gowym in God's family. God lays it out that gowym who accept Yisra'el and engage on behalf of Yisra'el, who accept the terms and conditions of the Covenant as they are laid out in the Towrah, who attend the Mow'ed Miqra'ey that we have the same access to the Covenant as do Jews.

However, Yahowah's message is to His people. He only speaks of gowym / gentiles when we are supporting Yisra'el, when we are negatively influencing Yisra'el, when we are abusing Yisra'el or when we are part of the events of the last days when Yahowah is trying to reconcile His relationship with Yisra'el.

That's why I had so much trouble with translating the 27^{th} chapter of Ezekiel about the color of the sails and the source of the wood for the masts for Tyre's boats and you just go, "So what?" Even if it were true, and it's not, why would anybody care? God's interest is on Yisra'el. If you don't like that, if you don't like Jews, then go away. God loves them in spite of themselves. Gowym only fit into this picture when they've ether been lambasted by God for negatively affecting His people, like Christians, Muslims and Progressives, or we're presented in this picture because we are supporting His people and therefore engaged in the Covenant. 'Am 'any / my family refers to Yisra'el – these are the descendants of 'Abraham, Yitschaq, and Ya'aqob. From the opening statement, Yisra'elites have been the cause of Yahowah's angst, the focus of His condemnation and the entire focus of His desire to reconcile that relationship.

This is so for a number of reasons:

First, Yahowah established His Covenant with Yisra'el, essentially adopting them into His Family. They were destined to inherit everything God had to offer. But because they were so readily misled, they were disinherited for a while.

Second, Yahowah liberated the Children of Yisra'el from being oppressed by religion and politics in Mitsraym /the Greek name Egypt. He revealed His *Towrah* | Guidance to them on their way home, speaking directly to these Hebrews in their language. And even though He led them into the Promised Land in spite of their hideous behavior, they showed no appreciation and quickly abandoned God.

Third, Yisra'elites were groomed and raised to be the shining example of what life would be like for those who listen to and trust Yahowah. Instead, they became infamous for being belligerent and rebellious. The realization that they did not listen, that they pursued the ways of the gentiles, worshiping false gods and giving homage to arrogant kings, broke Yahowah's heart. Our Creator and Father would watch as those He sought to love were humiliated and abused by those He asked them to avoid.

That's so very sad. God makes this painfully clear. He's done everything He could to lift up His children and they have done everything in their power to spit in His face. It's the saddest story ever told. And yet not because of them but because of Him He's going to reconcile this relationship. He is calling His people home. I don't think there will be a lot and I don't think God cares that there aren't a lot. But if you want to be among them, it's time to walk away from religion and politics and embrace Yahowah.

Fourth, Yisra'elites as a whole, not just Yahuwdym, were called to serve as Yahowah's witnesses, His prophets. And yet, because they forsook His instruction and forewent rational contemplation, Howsha' would be the last Yisra'elite prophet. The greatest opportunity ever afforded men and women by God was squandered and tossed away.

Lastly, Yahowah honors His promises, even when His people are undeserving. So, to save a remnant of Yisra'el, to reconcile their relationship with Yahuwdym and Himself, He would have to get their attention at a different time and in a different way because there wasn't a single Jew to whom He could speak. And as the ultimate insult to Israel's arrogance, a gowy was asked to reintroduce them to the Towrah and call them home.

Apart from Yahowah, human souls *damah* | perish. An estranged *nepesh* | conscious *damah* | ceases to exist. This is one of the most vital lessons we can learn from God, and it is at the forefront of this declarative statement.

God is telling us that for the thoughtless and faithful, there is no eternal life in Heaven nor everlasting punishment in Hell. Neither of those will come upon the thoughtless or the faithful. Instead, they will earn nothing, they will receive nothing. And while this may not register with some of our listeners tonight, it is essential to our understanding of Yahowah. If, instead, God had created a paradigm wherein those who were unaware of Him, who were misled about Him, or even who chose to reject Him were eternally tormented in Hell, He would be rendered unlovable and sadistic. But this religious perception is not reality. That is what we learn from *damah*.

She'owl | Hell is reserved for those who deliberately mislead others and abuse them. Rabbis will be very popular in Hell as will be priests, pastors, Imams and a lot of

politicians. Those who mislead others, particularly Jews, via religion, politics, patriotism, militarism, education, culture, or conspiracy, their punishment is not only deserved, recompense is the only way to be fair to those they harmed. The founders and principal catalysts for religion will all be there, along with a long list of emperors, kings, popes, pastors, imams, and rabbis.

We have all been invited to enjoy eternal life in *Shamaym* | Heaven with Yahowah, even though as few as one in a million will accept God's offer. We avail ourselves of this opportunity by listening to Yahowah by reciting His Towrah, by reading his prophets / Naby', wa Mizmowr / Psalms, and then responding appropriately to the five conditions of His Beryth and answering His invitations to attend His seven Miqra'ey.

Miqra'ey are the seven invitations that we are invited to attend:

Pesach is the first of them for the purpose of living forever, opening the doorway to life.

Matsah, the most important of them, which is not even celebrated anymore in Judaism, is the single most important day of the year for us. It is the day that the fungus of religion and politics is expunged from our souls so that we appear perfect in God's eyes so that when we are immortal, we still are capable of entering God's presence.

Bikuwrym / First Born Children which is to be adopted into Yahowah's family once we have been made immortal and perfect.

Then on Shabuw'ah, seven sevens later, we are enriched, empowered and enlightened so that we can be effective witnesses on behalf of Yahowah to convey His message to His people. The most important time to do that is on Taruw'ah. Taruw'ah is the date that I received this calling.

Taruw'ah is the event that we live part of the Yada Yahowah program seven days a week, 52 weeks a year. Taruw'ah means "to call out a warning" and "to express the good news" of Yahowah's message. It is the date the rabbis have corrupted to the Babylonian Rosh Hashanah / Head of the Year.

This leads to the most important day on God's calendar from His perspective, Yowm Kipurym / the Day of Reconciliations. It's not the Day of Atonement, it's not a "high holy day," it's not a day to afflict one's soul or to enter a fast. It is the day to celebrate our relationship and the reconciliation of our relationship with Yahowah. It is a date that the fulfillment is certain. Yowm Kipurym, Year 6000 Yah, October 2, 2033, when at 6:22 p.m. as the sun sets in the sky above Yaruwshalaim Yahowah will

return with the most amazing man in human history, Dowd / David who is the Messiah, the King of Kings, and our Shepherd.

This leads to a return to 'Eden where we camp out with Yahowah during Sukah. This whole 6,000 years from the time we were expelled from 'Eden to the time we return is all orchestrated so that Yahowah can restore the earth without the influence of religion, politics, militarism, conspiracies so that it's just Yahowah and His family celebrating Sukah for 1,000 years at which time we will witness the creation of a new universe.

And these seven Mow'ed Miqra'ey provide the five benefits of the Covenant which are: eternal life, being perfected by God, being adopted into His family, being enriched, empowered and enabled to live with Him forever.

We receive these benefits, as I said, not only by capitalizing on the benefits of these seven Mow'ed Miqra'ey but also simultaneously accepting the terms and conditions of the Covenant; walk away from religion and politics and to walk to God through these Mow'ed Miqra'ey, Pesach, Matsah in particular and allow Him to perfect us. To trust and rely on Yahowah as opposed to religion or government. To closely examine and carefully consider these specific terms and conditions of the Covenant so that we're in a position to know and understand them and therefore accept them. And, of course, as a sign of the Covenant to be circumcised as men and to circumcise our sons on the eighth day.

We talked about this several programs ago when we were talking about what is the sign of the Covenant. It is circumcision, but what is left after the covering has been clipped and tossed away? When you recognize what that is then you recognize that Yahowah's perception of sexuality, love, marriage, family, enjoyment, the creation of children and raising them in a loving family is very different than that of religion. God obviously does not have a problem with sexuality and yet religious men and women do.

He does not call for us to be monogamous, for us to engage in a marriage ceremony, He doesn't scream about divorce or doesn't say that we can only have sexual experiences with a married partner – Yahowah doesn't say anything about those things; they are all manmade. God is not a cosmic killjoy. It's the sign of His Covenant. He clearly wants us to enjoy ourselves, but you do so in a loving and responsible way. If we're going to engage in this kind of behavior, we can't be like the women marching saying, "My body, my choice." Because you had no responsible way to control your body, you are trying to force your choice on someone else. God wants us to be responsible. If you are going to engage in this kind of behavior, then you'd better be doing it with somebody you want to spend some time with because you might well conceive a child and that's the greatest blessing of all but that requires a committed relationship and an opportunity to create a loving and supportive home.

God created us as a model for what He was trying to achieve. When you look at every aspect of human nature, at the fact that we're an upright individual and not down there on our four feet or knees or slithering on the ground; we're an upright individual. We can walk with God. We're an individual created with unique vocal capacity and range so that we can speak with God. Our cognitive abilities in terms of language skills are beyond any other animal specifically designed so that we could do these very things - listen to God and come know Him. We were given a conscience in addition to consciousness so we could discern right and wrong, truth and lies, good and bad, productive and counterproductive, all these things as gifts to model us in that environment. We conceive children together as a couple and have a child that is totally dependent upon us. We are very different as men and women with different strengths and weaknesses, but together we are far more effective in surviving, enjoying life, creating the right kind of environment and of course in raising our children. We are literally created as the living embodiment of what God intended for the Covenant. We are a fragile individual, we can't just live out there on the open ground like deer, antelopes and foxes, etc. We build houses, we wear clothing, we benefit from fire, cooking our food, and working cooperatively with one another. So, we are made to resemble what God is trying to offer us in this Covenant relationship.

Dee, Kirk, do you want to add anything to that?

DEE: I've got to add a little something because I've been looking into this for a while now and I really appreciate all the imagery associated with the male the female dichotomies and how they work together, and like you said totally designed, intentionally created to demonstrate how the two become one and it's kind of a short form of six plus one equals seven. It's what God wants with us, it's a beautiful design and very well said by you.

YADA: Yeah. I love the design; God obviously loves the design, and He wants us to enjoy the design. He would not have made the focal point of the design in terms of the enjoyment and conception of children like He did unless He wanted us to enjoy our relationships.

Yisra'el has become so hideously misled. The way women are treated in Judaism is a great example. They have come to embody the worst of *damah*, having become the brunt of a sad story. Religious Jews have become a nightmarish parable unto themselves – the most universally maligned people in human history. We are reading the reason Jews have become the object of so many conspiracy theories. The conspiracy theories are wrong. They were brought on Jews by Jews. Had there not been rabbis misleading Jews they would never had happened; Christianity and Islam would never have happened.

Bely ha da'at is a bad thing. Ignorance is destructive, not bliss. God's people have fallen, just as has humanity at large, because far too many lack understanding. This is due to many factors, including being inundated by the religious, political, and conspiratorial with corrupted information. Those who *bely ha da'at* are without adequate knowledge. If you don't have adequate knowledge, there is no path to understanding. They have insufficient awareness to be discerning and thoughtful – which is why most believe, and why the world is awash in unfounded opinions.

One of the great challenges today is that information is so prevalent that without a filter, without being discerning, without being judgmental you have no way of determining what's true or false. I'm sent articles all the time and I read the first paragraph and say, "No that clearly is not true. Somebody is off on a wild goose chase." After a while if you know who Yahowah is, what He's offering, what He's rejecting it actually becomes pretty easy. When somebody wants to tell me this great story I'll say, No. It's not true. Let me explain to you why it's not true." But most people are incapable of doing that. The reason that politicians and conspiracies prevail is because their audience is ignorant and irrational. The reason religions prevail is because most people are ignorant and irrational.

KIRK: Don't you think that's what makes it so easy later if you study and read enough of the concepts that you find only really in Yada Yah, and in all these volumes, once you get those pretty sound basics of what Yahowah has to say that is most important to Him, the Mow'ed Miqra'ey, etc. when you go back and even if you're stuck with doing your translations or something out of a Masoretic text it's really easy to make the corrections. You know that's not true you know it can't be translated that way and then even if you go to all those English Bibles or even the Jewish Publication Society _____ you go, "No. wrong." I'm not that smart but I say, "No. That's wrong and this is why and if I had to confront someone this is why." It's like earlier you're talking about Yah gives us free will, so He can't make you obey or give you a law. Towrah cannot be law and still be free will.

YADA: When I'm translating Ezekiel it's a broken record because every statement is incorrect. It's so easy to demonstrate that they are incorrect and of course Yahowah's standard is that every statement has to be correct and yet in Ezekiel every statement is incorrect, and you wonder how is it that theologians and apologists for these religions write articles and say prophecy was fulfilled when every aspect of its false, and why people believe it when it's so obviously untrue, so easily disproven. I can tell people that I can give you 10,000 reasons to reject the Christian New Testament and Paul, all of them irrefutable, and yet they can't even process it, won't even try. The Haredi, the Ultra-Orthodox Jews, is the dominant religion within Yisra'el and the second largest in the United States. Reform is larger in the United States but Haredi being the fastest growing in Israel, the non-Haredi represents such a small percentage and a declining percentage of Judaism. The Haredi / the Ultra-Orthodox Jews, is a religion that was conceived in Ukraine between the 1700 and the 1800s and is a fairly new religion. If you were to tell them that Yahowah's name is easily pronounced, that His Towrah means "teaching and guidance," that He has seven Mow'ed Migra'ey that they aren't even observing the most important of the Mow'ed Miqra'ey, Matsah, that you've got everything regarding Pesach wrong, you're clueless as to what Bikuwrym is and what Shabuwa' means, you ignored and replaced Taruw'ah, that twirling chickens is not the answer for Kipurym, that Purim is a complete and utter myth, and that Hanukkah is repulsive to God, here's the truth, it's obvious, here's what the Covenant and Mow'ed Migra'ey represent and what Yahowah is offering, there isn't one in a million that would even listen. They would put their hands over their eyes and their fingers in their ears and run away. The only thing positive about the Haredim is that they're dressed for their own funeral. That's all they have going for them.

In the case of Yisra'elites, not all but far too many lack the will to recall the lessons of the Towrah. And without God's Guidance, they have become incapable of rationally analyzing the prescriptions for living Yahowah has provided.

While I'm certain that most listeners to this program have heard hundreds of programs before and have read most of Yada Yah and know that we're not denouncing Judaism in favor of Christianity or Islam or being atheist or agnostic, that is the furthest from the truth. Not only did I write Prophet of Doom which is the most comprehensive renunciation of Islam probably ever written, four volumes of Questioning Paul which utterly destroy the Christian New Testament and Paul as a person and the entire religion of Christianity, the reason that we are denouncing Judaism so aggressively as part of this program is because that's what Yahowah does. We go to where His words lead. God is disgusted with Christianity. The book of Habakkuk calls out Paul by name and calls him the Plague of Death. God really despises Christianity. Dowd / David's Psalms take direct aim against Christianity and Islam Yahowah directly associates with Satan. If you were to add every reference to Islam and Christianity and condemnation of it in the Towrah, Prophets and Psalms, they wouldn't total one percent of what Yahowah has to say against Judaism. The reason for that is gowym are not His people. It's possible for gowym to become part of Yahowah's family but you don't start there. The descendants of Abraham, Yitschaq and Ya'aqob / Yisra'el are His people. Judaism affects His

people more than any other religion and it's all bad. Nothing has harmed Jews more than Judaism; nothing has precluded Jews from knowing who Yahowah is and how to engage in a relationship with Him more than Judaism. In Judaism there is no salvation because they have no concept of what God is offering as a means to salvation. In Judaism, of course, they'll deny even the existence of Hell even though God's very verbose about what She'owl represents. They want to deny the devil / ha Satan and yet they'll incorporate the book of Ezekiel into their *Zohar* and it's authored by ha Satan.

Contrary to what the religious believe, we must think our way to God. He is not found at the end of faith's multicultural rainbow.

Yahowah's Towrah is comprised of His teaching and guidance, instructions and directions so that we are suitably educated. You must be educated to know, and you must be disciplined in your education so that you can transition from knowing to understanding by making the proper connections between things. But when God's dissertation on life is $ma'as \mid$ neglected or, worse, rejected, there is no $da'at \mid$ basis for understanding. When there is no $da'at \mid$ basis for understanding, what's left? When knowledge is rejected before we can even make the connections and associations needed to comprehend Yahowah's approach to life, then there is no hope. We cannot distinguish between right and wrong, differentiate between good and bad, or discriminate between the teachings of God and the edicts of man without access to verifiable information and the will to exercise good judgment regarding it.

Every single rabbi who has claimed to serve God is lying. The same is true for every pastor and priest, every minister and theologian. Not one knows Yahowah. In fact, they have all avoided Him as He has rejected them.

Yahowah designated specific individuals in well-defined roles to serve Him and His people. These initially included the *kohen* | priests. All of Lowy descent were asked to educate God's people and help them understand His instructions and attend His Miqra'ey in a way that would benefit them. But when the teachers forsook their education, they became useless and were discarded.

And while this prophecy clearly states that this was the reason behind the demise of the *kohen* | priests, there is more to the story. Yisra'elites had rejected Yahowah to the extent they had replaced Him. They had no interest in listening to their God, preferring to heed the myths associated with the gods they had purloined from the gowym.

Yet that god of Judaism who the Haredim will say deliberately tests and annoys men so they have the chance to prove their righteousness is not the god of the Towrah. God only tests us in one thing and it's an open book test: do you know the conditions of the Covenant, do you know that He has invited us to attend the Mow'ed Miqra'ey, do you know His name? He's not taking the Towrah and prophets away from you as you engage in this test, it's an open book test, but you've got to know where to look. You have to care enough to look, you've got to throw away the *Talmud*, the *New Testament* and the *Zohar*

However, you will notice that Yahowah did not replace kohen with rabbis. He simply $ma'as \mid$ rejected the priests – avoiding all contact with them. Therefore, Judaism's twisted variation of Replacement Theology, whereby rabbis have replaced the priests, is as irrational and inappropriate as Christianity's version whereby gentiles replaced Jews. Moreover, when Roman Catholics usurped the priestly title, they unwittingly demonstrated that they were not *kahan la' 'any* | ministering on God's behalf. Think about that.

In Judaism, the myth that rabbis draw their authority from God is as errant and deadly as the myth that their *Talmud* is an oral Torah with a legacy dating back to Moseh. Yahowah disowned His people, disinheriting and divorcing Yisra'el, because they consistently ignored His *Towrah*.

God's *Towrah* is more than what they call the "Five Books of Moses." Those books are exceedingly important. In Bare'syth we find the terms and conditions of the Covenant. Yatsa', corrupted to Exodus is actually from yatsa' / to draw out. We learned the path God provided for us to walk from man's corrupted world to His home and where God then gave us His Towrah so that as we move through this marvelous book of teaching, we come to Qara'/ Called Out. And in this book, God explains the purpose and the meaning of each of the seven Mow'ed Migra'ey and the Yowbel years and how we can engage in a relationship with Him going on to talk about the history of His people in the wilderness, their life and challenges that they experience but then leading to the most interesting book I think of all which is an exemplar of Yahowah's style. Yahowah tried speaking directly to His people and they freaked out. "Don't ever do that again!" I said, "Okay okay, I get it. I'm too scary for you. I know. I'm not trying to be. My voice is just too profound. You have no place to hide if I'm speaking directly to you and you really like to hide. There is no opportunity if I'm in your midst and speaking directly to you for you to go off and claim that a Talmud or some other nonsense is from Me. So, I understand that you don't want Me to speak directly to you." So, Dabarym is a really special book because it's just so Yahowah.

In *Dabarym* there's only one voice, Moseh's. Moseh has lived it. He has set there as God not only dictated the first four books of the *Towrah* to him, but also as Yahowah taught him. As Moshe went from being ignorant to knowing and from knowing to understanding, *Dabarym* is Moseh sharing that understanding with us but done the

way that God thinks it is best for us, and you're listening to the same technique here in this program. God likes to communicate through flawed individuals because they're real, because when His message is filtered through someone like Moseh it is more vital, it hits home, it resonates with us. It's not coming from a from a being whose intellect is infinitely greater than ours, it's coming from someone who's one of us, who is real, who's had the same challenges in life. And so, by communicating through us as God does in Dabarym, through Moseh's understanding of what He has taught him then those words can resonate with us. We can know what Moseh knew because he shared that understanding with us. What's Happening here is that I'm translating Yahowah's testimony and I'm sharing with you what it means. God could have gotten a big megaphone or could have a big video display in the sky such that everybody hears it in their language and can see a nice visual image of God and hear His voice and they'd all scurry for cover and we would have no choice but to listen to Him when instead He wants you to choose to listen to Him. He wants His message to be such that we can accept it so that it's not this thing that's beyond us but something that can be part of our lives, and in doing so if God picks somebody that has challenges with their spouse, with their children, has grown a few gray hairs along the way, has won and lost some battles along the way, had to develop some grit, has been mistaken and tried to correct what they have done that's been wrong, then that's the kind of person that God wants to work with particularly if they're dedicated, passionate and committed to the truth. That's what you're listening to tonight; it is what Yahowah did with Moseh.

Now, there's a big difference between Moshe and what you're hearing tonight. Moshe was a prophet; every word that he said was inspired by God to be precisely accurate although with his personality oozing through them. The same thing was true with Dowd, Yasha'yah, Yirma'yah, Howsha', the book we're reading now, all of them with their own personalities coming through, their own unique insights to what they had seen. What you're listening to now is the voice of a witness, someone who has listened to each of those prophets, contemplated what they had to say, discerned who was not a prophet, what things are not true – Christianity, Judaism, Islam, Progressive thought, who has had some successes and some failures, who is very passionate about what Yahowah revealed through His prophets communicating in a way that should resonate with people living today in the lingua franca of the world, the language that most Jews speak, and doing so in the way that God prefers.

Once a week for an hour and a half we do this program and yet 10 to 12 hours a day seven days a week we translate His testimony and comment on it. The written word is Yahowah's preference. We do this program on the spoken word to help draw your attention to the written word. So, we strongly encourage you to go to yadayah.com. If you're then drawn to this program through the efforts of those who like Dee who are engaged in social media outreach it is all for a singular purpose to draw your attention to the Yada Yah website where every one of these books is available in its entirety for free. They are wonderful resources. We not only don't charge anything, we wouldn't take your money if you threw it at us. All we want is for you to have the opportunity to know the truth. We want you to know that religion is bad and that a relationship with Yahowah is good.

Go to yada yada.com and see the beautiful Manowrah that Jackie gifted to us. See all those books that David has managed to put on the shelf and to have so beautifully presented and accessible. If you're just beginning, take down the first book, An *Introduction to God* "Words," the first volume, and begin there. It's all there for you. The volume that we're speaking from now is the eighth volume entitled "Separation." On the cover is a picture of the Arch of Titus as you'd go towards the Coliseum in Rome showing the diaspora and the enslavement of Yisra'elites and them carrying the Manowrah, separation from God and from home. Read it if you are Jewish and you want to know what God had to say about Judaism and about this time of reconciliation.

Howsha' 4:6, the passage that we have been considering, is as important as anything ever written, "My people are destroyed because of their ignorance, because they're unaware, because they do not understand." What's the solution? Shed your ignorance, read the *Towrah*, come to know Yahowah. That's the remedy, it is the antidote and it's not just the remedy for death, dying and the vanquishing of one's soul, it is the doorway to eternal life as a member of Yahowah's family, inheriting the entire universe, a doorway to dimensions beyond those that we know to the entire universe. That's the opportunity to sing songs with Dowd / David, to rub shoulders with Moseh not as an inferior but as a brother, the opportunity to sit down and have a chat or go for a long walk with the Creator of the Universe who is going to serve you as a father serves a child, lifting you up, holding your hand, guiding and teaching you. I haven't found a place where we praise God. It's a place where God lifts us up, empowers us, teaches us, cares for us and enjoys our company. We're as close as Father and Son, Father and Daughter of the Covenant. That's what God is offering

We'll pick this up next week. I'm sorry I got a little carried away; Howsha' 46 just happens to be one of my favorite statements because once I began this 22 years ago one of the things that struck me is that Yahowah is knowable. Everything about Him is knowable. He presents information in a way that we can understand, and we can think our way to God based on the information He has given us. You can know Him and can be certain of all the promises I've just shared. So, when Yahowah affirms it in writing, as He has here in Howsha', that's very meaningful because it's the principal difference between everything you will read and hear as part of Yada Yahowah and any religious path where they want you to believe. We want you to toss all your beliefs out the door before you even begin and replace them with what you can know and understand.

I think if you begin reading the first volume of *An Introduction to God* you will enter into a world that is brilliant, uplifting, emancipating and enlightening. You're going to love Yahowah, you're going to love the Covenant family and love life. So, we'd encourage you to do so.
