Shabat Study by Yada, January 13, 2023

Good evening and welcome to Yada Yah Radio. I'm happy to be broadcasting to you from the lovely Virgin Islands. I understand that the Continental United States has gone from bomb cyclones and atmospheric rivers to tornados. It's been devastating where you are, Kirk, and you have another four or five storms headed your way; it looks like all the rivers have risen. My old home turf, Montecito received another mud bath from all this. You showed me a picture of Carmel Beach with the beautiful white sand now covered with mud. Mother Nature doesn't seem to like California.

I was impressed to read in yesterday's newspaper that with the four to five feet of rain received and another four to five feet coming the drought is still not over. You know you're dealing with smart, well-educated people when after all the rivers have crested over maximum, they haven't figured out how to dig a hole in the ground to hold water so they can use it later and then dig a ditch to bring it from one place to another.

While living in Montecito my water bill was \$7,000 a month so I had water trucked in and built an independent water system and they fined me for that even though it was an artesian well where the water just ran out into the sea. They wanted control over the whole thing. They didn't want anyone to work around their precious system.

It does warrant a quick review because we've been talking about the weather on this program and on Shattering Myths for the better part of 20 years now. I originally said that it wasn't climate change they were touting but global warming. They went away from global warming because at the time the earth wasn't warming. We went through about a seven to eight-year period where there was no discernable temperature change at all. During that time, I said that we ought not be talking about and threatening people with global warming in a time when the earth wasn't really warming, but that it would warm.

I learned upon investigation that the earth has gone through many hot and cold periods, some massive. Mastodon have recently been found in Greenland and Iceland. Mastodon is a tropical species which is not able to survive the cold and if they lived today would today live in Africa. The analysis of their diet was tropical

fruit which means the temperature in Iceland and Greenland had to be in a range of 30 to 50 degrees warmer than it is now. So, the earth has gone through these warming and cooling periods without any contribution from humankind (we weren't around at the time). I also learned that there are also more moderate cycles than there are large ones, like the last ice age or the warming period we were talking about in Greenland and Iceland. There have been 600-year cycles where the temperature has risen two degrees and dropped two degrees from the norm. Since we now have about 5,000 years of recorded history, we can trace it back over that time period and see that the warming periods are exceedingly favorable for humankind and that the cooling periods are when we get pandemics, plagues, mass deaths and upheaval in civilization because people are starving and malnourished. Beyond the 5,000 years of recorded history where we can see the effect and wouldn't want the temperature to be dropping because that's when mankind has the roughest go of it, we can go back many hundreds of millions of years, perhaps a billion years, and in the shallow water sediment of oceans we can see that every 600 years on average we go through a warming and cooling period because there are different kinds of plants and sea life that flourish when the water temperature fluctuates up and down. To blame humankind for this when there is recorded history of this occurrence over hundreds of millions of years is a problem in our terms of our culture. It's how conspiracies exist; something is taken out of context and all the relevant information is not considered. My view has always been that temperatures will rise and should have begun to do so around 1850 which is when the last cold period ended, and we began an upswing to a warming period. That's why when the first photographs of the glaciers appeared, they have receded since then because we have started to come out of that last cold period into a warming period.

There are negative and positives both ways. The positives of the warming periods are the Earth's temperate regions where most people live are far more habitable, food production is easier worldwide and disease is less because people are better nourished during the warming periods. The negative of the warming periods is that some of the storms, like tornadoes, which require the swelling up of thunderstorms and supercells, and hurricanes tend to be more prolific as the temperature rises. I also expect there to be more extremes, like the rain that California is getting now, and I would expect it to get worse not better over the next decade. It's going to be a minor part of where we are unless we somehow end up with something in the nature of a solar disruption whereby there are going to be a lot of other things that are far more egregious to us. So, be prepared for what is to come; it's going to get worse in terms of floods and droughts, winds, hurricanes and tornadoes.

Warming trends tend to increase food production although we have a counter to that. America's stupid intervention in the Ukraine, sanctions on Russia and the supply chain disruption that was a result COVID had a huge negative effect on food production. There are probably now 50 countries out of the 200 plus in the world today that are on the precipice of anarchy and destruction. Some of them are barely managing like Chile, for example, where the first and second floors in most buildings in Santiago are boarded up because of the rioters. Because the country has to function somewhat, they've persuaded the rioters to agree to only riot now I think on Fridays. So, you can riot one day a week, spend four days working and then spend two days with your family.

I love to make fun now of Chile because a youngster who has all the qualifications of my pets and is also anti-Semitic, is now head of the country. May they continue to be plagued. It's a wild world out there and it's going to get progressively worse.

To give you an Ezekiel update, I just finished earlier today the 28th chapter and it is the wildest ride one could possibly imagine. The first chapter has been fun; no rapes, no prostitution. In fact, up to this point 25 ways to kill a Jew is the running theme; Ezekiel is really an anti-Semitic psychopath. But by the time he gets to the 28th chapter he is all over himself and he depicts himself as one of the cherubs that were on the walls of Eden, one of the four people allowed into Eden; he presents himself as part of their the whole setup of Eden and how one little indiscretion got him on the wrong side of God and what a shame for a creature that was created perfect and is the most beautiful and most brilliant. I mean he really waxes poetic about himself. It's also interesting because you can go back to the beginning of the third century when the numbskull Tertullian, who gave us the Trinity and is the father of Christian theology, even recognized that the 28th chapter of Ezekiel is about Satan and the death of Satan. What he didn't figure out, of course, is that everything else in it is also about Satan and that Chapter 28 was actually written by Satan to depict his rise and fall. So, it really is an interesting experience. The chapter has gone through its two edit passes, and hopefully it'll be added to the book. If you go to yadayah.com the two volumes of *Babel* are located after the *Coming Home* series and before the Questioning Paul series on the bookshelf. Volume One of Babel is complete and Volume Two is a work in progress, complete with translations.

I will tell you that when you do something as bold, something I don't think has ever been done in 2,500 years, to not only accuse Ezekiel of being a false prophet, which others have done because of his derelict prophecies regarding Tyre (he got them all

wrong) and maybe two people have written to say that the scene that I cover in the 5th chapter (I think it's Ezekiel 16) is a rape scene and that it's graphic sexually. So, two people that had written briefly on it didn't know the full scope of it but at least they tried to bring it to the forefront that this is graphic and grossly inappropriate, and as I said Tertullian was the first and probably the only one who has tried to identify this with Satan in the 28th chapter. Although if you google Satan on Wikipedia it will bring up all three places where he is detailed. It's got to bother Christians no end to see that Ezekiel 28 is one of those three places along with Genesis 3 where he is in the Garden and also Isaiah 14 which is the most comprehensive presentation of it. So, it is a is most gratifying to read Satan admitting that he indeed is the author of this and is the Lord of Babel. There is zero question and ... because I said there's no one who has written from beginning to end that says this book is not just about a false prophet, this is the voice of the Adversary; this is Satan's playbook, his autobiography, it is what he intends. Fortunately, he's not going to get his wishes, but you will certainly understand him when you've read this book.

Let's return to where we left off last week. We were speaking about one of the most powerful passages found anywhere among the prophets, Howsha' 4:6. I'll read it through it again and then we'll uh we'll pick up with the commentary on this remarkable statement.

"My people ('am 'any) can be translated "people," "family" or "a nation." It's not a hard and fast rule but the overwhelming percentage of the time that it is used 'am refers to Yisra'el and Yahuwdah. If Yahowah is speaking of non-Yisra'elites, He will typically use gowy. Gowy and gowym can also be non-Yisra'elite people. It is often written as gentile although that's kind of an odd term because gentile was the Latin term meaning "not Roman." Also, "nation" is a translation of gowym. So, when you see 'am Yahowah is almost always speaking of His people, of Yisra'el, His family.

"My people ('am 'any) are destroyed and they will perish (damah – they are ruined and will cease to exist, having become the brunt of a sad story (nifal perfect – the people have destroyed themselves and will suffer the consequence for a protracted, but limited, period of time for what they have done which is destructive and ruinous))

When He says that He's not talking about 100%. He didn't say that all (*kol*) of His people would cease to exist because it's not true. The overwhelming preponderance of Yisra'elites' and Jews' souls have ceased to exist. That's not a penalty, it's just the acknowledgment of what's true and it's being affirmed here. "My people are

destroyed, and they will cease to exist." Any souls / people who during their life have not accepted the five terms and conditions of the Covenant and who have not accepted and acted upon the invitations to Yahowah's seven Mow'ed Miqra'ey, at some point in their life haven't come to know Yahowah by His name, have not come to accept Him as God, have not come to like and respect Him, then those souls cease to exist at the end of their mortal existence. They aren't sent to Hell; there is no punishment or reward. That's the majority of souls. Those that do accept the invitations of the Covenant, come to know Yahowah by name and attend His Mow'ed Miqra'ey end up as part of Yahowah's family and get to live with Him in His home forever. That is a very small percentage of people. It is less than one in a million by Yahowah's own instructions to us. In particular, the second instruction that He etched on the first of the two Tablets that said there will be thousands who closely examine and carefully consider the terms and conditions of His Covenant and will be the ones who receive His mercy. Thousands amongst billions is one in a million. So, the percentage that participates in the Covenant and live forever is small.

There is a much larger group than the Covenant family but hugely smaller in number than those whose souls are simply dissipated. Those are the souls of the people who because of their religion, politics or conspiracies go about misleading people. If you mislead people away from God through a conspiracy, religious and/or political ideology, even through overt patriotism or anything that leads people away from God, there is a consequence. That consequence is to spend eternity incarcerated in She'owl which is akin to a black hole. There is no torture, but it is an eternal existence without any escape associated with the most religious, political, militaristic and conspiratorial people who have existed. So, it would not be very pleasant.

Those are the three options. God is not condemning anyone. He's just saying that they will be destroyed, and their soul will cease to exist upon their mortal demise.

because of (*min* – from) **a lack of understanding as a result of corrupted information** (*bely ha da'at* – being without adequate knowledge, having insufficient awareness, and deficient discernment, lacking the will to recall what is important and the capacity to rationally analyze the data to comprehend it (infinitive substantive – being ignorant and irrational regarding these prophetic revelations has come to demonstrably define Yisra'elites over the long chasm of time)).

The thing that separates those who know Yahowah from those who don't, those who believe from those who trust, is that accurate information and processing that information in such a way that you understand it, making the connection between things that can be trusted. The only place you are going to find valid information about God is the Towrah, Prophets and Psalms. You can't just read it, you must analyze it, think about it and make sure your translation of it is accurate. Even

reading it in Hebrew, you must be careful because a modern rendering of the ancient Hebrew is likely to take a bent that is based on the Masoretic text which is to use their diacritical marks to change the meanings of words. They will also render a word such as 'anah (to reply, to answer, to respond) which is correctly rendered that way in about 95% of its uses, but they will render 'anah as "to afflict, to abase and humble." So, they will have an individual afflicting themselves on the Day of Reconciliations (which is not a way that you would reconcile a relationship with anyone) rather than responding ('anah) to Yahowah's invitation. So, even if you're reading in Hebrew, it's important to know that you'd better to go back to the original Hebrew text and translate the words based upon the original lettering.

This is because (ky - for the express reason that) you ('atah) have avoided and rejected (ma'as - you have spurned and despised), refused and disdained, showing an aversion to (qal perfect – revealing that the avoidance was complete and the rejection was literal)) the process which leads to understanding $(ha \ da'at - \text{the knowledge required to comprehend})$, the information which enables discernment).

One thing that is so peculiar for most people is that they think that religious faith, religious rituals and laws, religious behavior and compliance, being patriotic, doing good deeds and believing is what leads to God and what causes one to be saved. It's not true. God says that souls perish

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There is a process which leads to understanding and it has nothing to do with faith. Faith is a tremendous liability because with faith you have no interest in knowledge. Knowledge and understanding eliminate faith; there is no faith when you know. Often the information that you come to know, particularly when it pertains to God, is contrary to every religion. So, knowledge and understanding destroy the credibility of religion. Beyond that, once you know and understand you have eliminated faith, so it's very important to understand the concept that God is not encouraging people to be religious. In fact, His problem is that people are religious and religious people are destroying their own souls causing them to dissipate.

So, God is encouraging here that you come to acquire rather than reject and avoid quality information, and that process leads to understanding, He wants you to focus on what matters. He's going to tell us in a moment what matters. It's the one that matters; study His Towrah. When He speaks of this in a moment, Towrah does not

mean law nor is it limited to the five books that Moseh conveyed to us. *Towrah* means "source from which guidance, teaching, instruction and direction flow." It is based upon, according to God, the Hebrew verb *yarah* which conveys exactly that thought. The Towrah is a source of God's teaching, instructions, guidance and directions. When you study His teaching using your *neshamah* / conscience to be discerning regarding it, you can make the connections between the things that He has shared to understand the message. Once you make that transition from observing the Towrah, which permeates the Prophets and Psalms because it's His teaching and guidance which permeates all of them, and you make the connections between everything He has shared, you will come to understand and when you come to understand you will not only know Yahowah you are also in the perfect place to enjoy a relationship with Him.

Therefore (wa – so then), **I will consistently reject you and avoid you** (ma'as 'atah – I will actually disassociate from you and will rebuff you, coming to despise and loathe you as vile, showing an aversion to you, spurning you (qal imperfect)) **from serving as priests and ministers** (min kahan – from acting as counselors and clerics, working as teachers or facilitators (piel infinitive – this decision to curtail the priestly service is being imposed upon Yisra'el by Yahowah, emphatically, demonstrably, and continually)) **on My behalf** (la 'any – for Me or to approach Me).

Which means those who are claiming as Jews, or any religious person, to be serving God as priests and ministers are lying. It's very clear.

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It's not, "I will reject for the next 15 minutes or until Jesus comes." Nope.

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It is saying there can be no rabbis that are intermediaries between Jews and God. It means there are no priests that serve in that role. The Catholic Church and Orthodox Church are lying as is anyone claiming to be a minister of God.

And since (wa) you have consistently ignored and forgotten, failing to remember or respond to (shakach – you have overlooked and lost sight of the significance of, ceasing to care about, and failing to mention (qal imperfect – actually

and continually become oblivious to)) the *Towrah* | Teaching and Guidance of your God (*Towrah 'elohym 'atah* – Your God's Towrah Instructions and Directions, Your God's Source of Leadership and Path to Follow, the Almighty's Education; derived from: *tow* – God's signed, written, and enduring, *towrah* – way of treating people, *tuwr* – giving us the means to explore, find, and choose, *yarah* – the source of instruction, training, supervision, and direction which flows from God, *tuwb* – providing answers that facilitate our restoration and return, even our reply to that which is *towb* – good, pleasing, beneficial, and right, and that which causes us to be loved, to become acceptable, and to endure, *tahowr* – purifying and cleansing us, thereby *towr* – providing us with the opportunity to change our attitude and thinking toward God), I also (*'any gam*) will ignore and forget your children (*shakah ben 'atah* – I will overlook your sons, lose sight of your children, and consider your offspring as worthless (qal imperfect))." (*Howsha'* / He Saves / Hosea 4:6)

The Towrah is Yahowah's source of teaching and guidance. It is the only place where you can come to know what God is offering and expects from us in return. It is the only place where you will be introduced to Him by name and come to know Him well enough to decide whether or not you like, respect and even love Him.

If you look at religions, Judaism has replaced the Towrah with their Talmud; they even call their Talmud the "Torah." Christianity has essentially annulled the Towrah replacing it with their "New Testament." While Islam claims the Quran confirms the Towrah it's just the opposite and contradicts it in every possible way. So, the three most famous religions, Judaism, Christianity and Islam have excluded themselves based upon this statement as have all but maybe one in a million people.

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That means that it's long since over for those who ignore the Towrah. God is saying, "I can't continually try to convey My message to awaken generation after generation; I've run out of hope. I've given you My guidance and instruction and have done everything I can to liberate and help you to appreciate this relationship. If you're not going to do it, then it's going to have to be a time out – I'm going to withdraw from your children and your children's children." It's harsh medicine, but this time out is from around 700 BCE and even past today. Yahowah is doing His best to awaken His family, Yisra'elites and Yahuwdym, but the time of the prophets is long past.

This statement from God is the one-two punch that destroys Judaism. Yahowah has said that Yisra'el has ceased to be rational regarding the Towrah. They much prefer their Talmud and don't even know that it conflicts in every possible way with His Towrah teaching. There is nothing about Hasidic Judaism that is a match for the Towrah. They have even made their Shabat so onerous that it is the hardest day of the week because of all the things you cannot do. They don't spend any time on that day observing or celebrating a relationship with Yahowah, they won't even say His name. There isn't a single Jew that knows the five terms and conditions or the five benefits of the Covenant or that understands the intent of the seven Mow'ed Miqra'ey, which is the path to God, or even celebrates them apart from those who have come to know Yahowah and what He's offering through these programs and books.

God's prophetic pronouncement is both consistent with our observable reality regarding rabbis and diametrically in opposition to Judaism, Christianity and Islam. God began this by saying, "My people," so He is addressing Jews.

As I have mentioned, *Towrah* does not mean law as the religious profess. It is comprised of teaching and guidance, things that we can learn from, but we cannot obey. The Towrah is Yahowah's, the Talmud is rabbinical. The fate of our souls and those of our children hinge upon that which we rely or on or that which we choose to believe. Both are not acceptable and is not an option. Yisra'el is destroyed and Yisra'elites perish, ceasing to exist, because they do not understand the difference between Yahowah's teachings and man's laws. There's only one way to participate in the *Beryth* / Covenant, there is one path to Shamaym / Heaven. We accept it and teach it to our children, or we will be forgotten by God just as surely as their parents ignored Yahowah.

The fate of every soul is determined by this formula. We come to know and understand by studying the Towrah / teaching of our God. Yahowah accepts or rejects us solely on this basis.

There is something to ponder here since God's people are destroyed for lack of understanding His Towrah: How can faith be an alternative? After all, faith is a substitute for knowledge. God is ruling all religious approaches. The larger human institutions grow, it is a fact the worse they become. That has been the truth for the last 6,000 years of recorded history. Whether it's been empires, civilizations, nations or institutions, its gang mentality. It's the same with the participants, and principalities if you will, as it is with religion. They not only feed upon people's willingness to acquiesce and be controlled, but the leaders of such institutions are also emboldened by the increased access to sex, power and money.

And so, as it is with the cleric, so it is with the king and those they who are conned. It is what Yahowah has said. Many have been lured into a false belief that civilization is a positive term and that man has grown and prospered over time, but it's just not true. The history of civilization is hellish. Every civilization until about a hundred years ago imposed the caste system and in that caste system there was no upward mobility. Many, like the Roman caste system, had about 15 different levels. The slave was the lowest level; the highest were the Caesars, Emperors or Kings and only they had free will. And even then, they had to placate the religious and military leaders to be able to rule and live.

Also, until the last hundred years women had no rights. We talk glowingly of ancient Greece and yet in ancient Greece women had fewer rights than we afford our pets. They were vicious. Most civilizations lived on slavery, that's why they were so warlike; they needed slaves for everything. In ancient Athens, for example, about 80% of the population were slaves. The same thing would be true with a Roman town. These are really despicable conditions and if you study the history of civilization, you find the history of war and that really hasn't changed. Even the superpower of the day, the United States of America, claiming to be peaceful, has engaged in well over 100 wars in the 400 years since the Europeans invaded this continent and displaced the native peoples. Over 100 different distinct wars in 400 years.

This last one will probably be our undoing as we have engaged in a proxy war with Russia in the Ukraine. I think it will end in a nuclear exchange. That is the nature of large civilizations.

The largest civilization on Earth is the Roman Catholic Church with a billion five people. It's reprehensible and probably the single greatest detriment to humankind. No organization has been more anti-Semitic for a longer period of time or done more harm to Jews than the Roman Catholic Church and it is a direct outgrowth of Imperial Rome. In fact, there's really no distinction as Imperial Rome morphed into Roman Catholicism. So, be aware that God's not impressed with nations, He does not like patriotism or patriots, He does not like militaries, He does not view them as protecting the people's freedoms or liberties. He is opposed to these things and that's why the first condition of the Covenant is to walk away from religion and politics.

So, as we press on through Howsha' the next statement reads,

"So as (ka) they grew in number and as the rabbis became more influential $(rabab\ hem\ -$ they increased in population and became more numerous and self-exalting), so much the more (ken) they missed the way (chata' – they were misled and went in the wrong direction, retreating from what is right and becoming too culpable, blameworthy, and offensive (qal perfect)) to approach Me $(la\ 'any\ -$ concerning Me).

I exchanged (*muwr* – I substituted (hifil imperfect)) **their reputation and reward** (*kabowd hem* – their honor and respect, their status and forthcoming abundance) **for** (*ba*) **shame** (*qalown* – dishonor and disgrace, ignominy and infamy, an exceedingly low status, engendering slander and public humiliation)." (*Howsha*' / He Liberates / Hosea 4:7)

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That's the truth of the matter.

With the previous statement excommunicating the *kohen* / priest, it is by recognizing that *rabab* serves as the basis of rabbi that this becomes a rather biting indictment. As the *rabab* | number of rabbis has increased dramatically. I think there is a chief rabbi for everything imaginable and as they have grown, *ken chata la' 'any* | so much the more they have misled people and missed the way to approach God. The rabbis were culpable and offensive to Yahowah – just as His name and approach were repulsive to them.

If you listen to them today as they engage in politics having allowed themselves to be bribed to support the Netanyahu coalition in Israel, and you just cringe with how these religious nut cases have presented themselves as if they define what it means to be a Jew. Being a Jew is not about ethnicity anymore, according to the rabbis. It's about whether or not you are Ultra-Orthodox. The more religious you are the more God disdains a person. They are, and have been, the greatest threat to the Jewish people for the better part of 2,000 years. The greatest threat to Jews is Judaism and the rabbis who promote it.

To be fair, such is the case with every religion. People go along to get along. They assume that their religion is right because so many people believe it. That's the whole sales pitch of the Haredim. They see everybody dressing in the stupid black garb and black hat with the same stupid curlicues, the women who have complied and shaved their heads, dress up in tents and forego all freedoms allowing themselves to be treated as numbskulls that are too stupid to read the Towrah or make decisions, too polluted to be around men, and they allow themselves to endure this because every woman around them has submitted because not to submit is to be ostracized. And, of course, the rabbis give them "kosher" phones so they can't call the rape hotline, cannot search for the truth online and have no other information other than the venom that the rabbis are feeding them. And so, it's insular and they go along to get along. For most of human history, deceptions have held sway.

When I wrote *Prophet of Doom* I was constantly told we have to be right, we're the fastest growing religion, there's a billion five of us, there's one of you therefore you're wrong and we're right. I could have taken that approach during the time of Imperial Rome and the religion of Imperial Rome was the only acceptable religion and so it was by a factor of a billion to one if you spoke out against it. Before then we could have gone to Greece or Carthage, to Babylon or to Assyria. The history of mankind is that the overwhelming percentage of people have been wrong almost all the time. So, if you're believing something that is popular you are absolutely wrong with God. In fact, this is one of God's single most repeated themes which is that He is set apart, everything important to Him is set apart and that if you're not set apart then you are common and profane and to be common or profane is to adhere to something that is popular. So, if you are among the most popular religions in Israel, you are considered profane by God and not set apart to Him. The same thing would be true with Christianity which is the world's most popular religion or the second most popular religion, Islam. By the very nature of their popularity, they become wrong because they're the antithesis of being set apart unto God.

Now, Howsha' 2:7 also presents an ironic twist. As people grow in stature, they recede from God. The more people move in one direction, the more likely it is that they are headed in the wrong direction. The more people strive to be influential, the more insignificant they become. Humankind has substituted wealth for an eternal reward and has exchanged the illusion of power for its genuine manifestation. This is particularly true among the Haredim in Israel.

Our appreciation for Yahowah's prophetic testimony grows when we set what He has revealed beside a long analysis of human history and human malfeasance. A recounting of the exploits of civilizations leaves the observant and moral with the realization of just how awful men and women have been, particularly since we have written these 26 volumes thus far all available for free at yadayah.com, *yada*' meaning "to know" *yah* is the familial form of Yahowah and have done more than 10,000 radio programs for Yisra'elites. We speak for you and to you. Of all people Yisra'elites should know how horrendous civilizations have been.

Look at what happened with the Assyrians brutalizing Israel and brutalizing the Northern Kingdom for no other reason than they were there. The Assyrians wanted to dominate trade routes and so anyone that didn't capitulate and pay them tribute, and the tribute had to be so egregious that the people starved, were bludgeoned to death. The Assyrians hauled away 10 of the 12 tribes right in around 700 and change BCE. And they were brutal. They put nose rings through the Jews, chained them together and made them walk nude from where they were taken and crucified and brutalized hundreds of thousands and hauled away millions. It wasn't very much after that that when the Babylonians defeated the Assyrians that they demanded their tribute and when it didn't happen the way they wanted they attacked Israel in 597 BCE. Then when Israel said, "Well maybe we should go with Egypt since there was a hiccup between Egypt and Babylon we'll pay our tribute there," which is basically a bribe to survive, the Babylonians said, "Well there's a consequence for that boys." They came back and after a three-year siege they destroyed Jerusalem. They hauled virtually every Jew into slavery, at least those they didn't kill. They trashed, plundered and burned Jerusalem, tore down the Temple, hauled everything away; they were brutal, and it wasn't just them. Not long after them the Greeks came. The Greeks have this reputation for being democratic and therefore peaceable. No. They were thugs. There are very few people as mean-spirited as was Alexander the Great and the generals that divided up his kingdom upon his death; they were savages. So, the Greeks came in and they tormented Jews; but they were pussycats compared to the Romans. Imperial Rome, in fact even during the Republic was Pompeii, invaded Israel and bludgeoned Jews around 66 BCE. Then Vespasian and his son Titus that bludgeoned Israel and destroyed the Temple in 70 CE and then Hadrian lured them back and was the most brutal of all when he began the diaspora crucifying countless

Jews. How could you imagine civilization being anything other than cruel? Then out of Imperial Rome grew the Roman Catholic church and for a better part of 1,500 years thereafter Jews were condemned as sub-human, demonic and forced to live and in ghettos. They had no rights and anything the Roman Catholic Church could do to terrorize and subjugate them they did.

The history of the Roman Church and Jews is horrific. They were part and party to the rise of Nazi Germany, and it happened all over again. And between those two we had the birth of Islam, the most satanic of religions that make killing Jews the highest reward that a Muslim can achieve.

Then you have the empires today that are progressive, socialistic and communistic and the Progressives have become enemies of Israel. So, if any nation, any people ought to understand that politics doesn't work, that nations are almost universally anti-Semitic and that the results of partnering with them, doing business with them is deadly for Jews.

So, our appreciation for Yahowah's prophetic testimony just grows the more open we are to studying the history of humanity. And as I've shared with you it is true that individually we humans can be good or bad, some are resolutely awful, some are extraordinarily charitable, but collectively we're horrendous and there aren't very many if any examples of large nations, empires or institutions where people have behaved well.

We engage in human sacrifice to appease the gods. In fact, we are doing it now with Progressives in the mutilation of children under the transgenders; we are literally mutilating our children. We have a history of enslaving our neighbors so that we prosper by their toil. We impose our politics and economic schemes and claim to be righteous and democratic. We rape the planet, rob it of its resources, and are murderous while pretending to be moral and peaceful. Lies are preferred over truth, control to freedom, religion to responsibility and to a relationship with God.

One example is there has finally been some uprising in Congress, I don't know where it's going to go, but there's the realization that we have squandered well over a hundred billion, maybe 150-200 billion dollars, on killing Russians in the Ukraine and that much of that money has no accountability and even the part that has accountability none of it should have been spent. We've spent more money killing Russians in the Ukraine coming ever closer to nuclear war than we spend on the infrastructure of the United States. We are sending them so many weapons that our military is saying that we're no longer defensible as a nation. So, there's a group of Republicans that are finally saying, "Please, we need an audit, we need to stop this, this is insane." Who knows how long that'll last because of politics and immediately

everybody's having a field day with Biden having classified documents in his garage. It was okay because there was a neat old car in that same garage, a Corvette Stingray, so who would care for the classified documents if you've got a neat car there. That looked embarrassing since he went out of his way to condemn Trump for the same crime. We'll get lost in our knickers and take the eye off the ball in the Ukraine. I bring up the Ukraine because it is the place where truth died. That was the first casualty of that war. Since 2006, I've been talking about why we shouldn't have done this in the Ukraine, what the consequence is going to be and how it's ultimately going to lead to a nuclear confrontation, so this is not a new topic. It's only recently that a very small number of people have joined in and recognized that what we're doing is insane.

One of the things that we all ought to think about is that as we establish enormous militaries, and we equip the killers with weapons of mass destruction, that this is not conducive to life. When we are indoctrinated to praise soldiers and those wielding the instruments of death and we believe that the least free and most destructive institutions on Earth, our militaries, are responsible for our liberty and our prosperity we're being stupid, we're being played for fools. We tax the productive and reward the unproductive thinking that we're being progressive and compassionate. We divide people into groups based upon the color of their skin and then we blame others for being racist.

And should someone raise their head above the crowd to demonstrate the degrading duplicity of it all, we slander and crucify the lone voice of reason. We will even accept a god or reject the God based not on the testimony of God but of men.

When engaged in pursuing their political or religious ambitions, people are almost universally rotten...

"They feed upon ('akal – they are fed and nourished by, even prey upon) the wrongdoing and sin offerings (chata'th – the iniquity and propitiations, the errant ways and misguided beliefs) of My people ('am' any – My family).

These souls (nepesh huw') lift up and accept, promote and honor (nasa' – they elevate and advance, forgive and even respect), their perversity and wrongdoing, even their depravity (wa 'el 'awon hem – their wicked ways and resulting liability, their iniquity and injustice). (Howsha' 4:8)

And so (wa) likewise, it will be the same (hayah ka - it is identical) for the people (ha 'am) as it will be (ka) for the priest (ha kohen).

I will hold both of them accountable (wa paqad 'al huw' – I will take stock of them, judging and punishing them) for their ways (derek huw' – for their conduct).

I will repay them, bringing back upon them (wa shuwb la huw' – I will require restitution, seeking retribution for) the foolish, beguiling, and cruel things they have done (ma'alal huw' – for their oppressive practices, malevolent deeds, and malicious characterizations; from 'alah – to act foolishly and wantonly)." (Howsha' / He Delivers / Hosea 4:9)

Well, that means that the old adage of "Don't blame me, that other person misled me." That was the excuse by every Nazi after the war, "It wasn't my fault, I was just following orders." God's not going to buy that. God's not going to buy, "It's not my fault that I dress it up like I was going to a funeral and treated my daughter as if she had no value and indoctrinated my son in this foolish religion because the rabbi made me do it". No. He's really clear here. It's the religious behavior, the sin offerings of My people that are repulsive. They lift up, honor and celebrate the perversity and the depravity. (God's talking about His people so this is talking about Judaism, and it rings true for Christianity and Islam) They're absolutely celebrating the lies, and so God finally says, "Enough already. If you all want to celebrate these lies and tell each other how wonderful you are then you can have each other but understand that ultimately there's going to be accountability."

Now particularly with Israel. Israel has no excuse. God liberated Israel and formed His Covenant with Israel. He delivered His Towrah to Israel, He walked with them, gave them the Land of Israel, performed His acts of restoration within Israel, built His home in Israel. He's done everything for His people Israel, so Israelites are without excuse; you ought to know better. And so, He's going to repay the foolish, beguiling and cruel things that Israelites have done to one another, and recompense is not going to be fun because you're without excuse. Yahowah through Howsha' has told you to stop being religious. Start listening to Him, to start thinking as opposed to believing. And if you don't want to listen to Him then understand there will be recompense.

I think this is true both literally and symbolically. If not for people's individual and collective sense of guilt and implied hellish consequences, religions wouldn't exist. Rabbis and priests prey on people's fear of the unknown and on their fear of punishment. As a result, they devour the funds of the unsuspecting by promising their victims that their donations will somehow exonerate them and elicit favor from God.

It's really a cruel joke; but who do you blame? Do you blame the rabbi, priest or the Imam who is collecting on this and making money out of it and lying to the people or the people who allow themselves to be deceived? God says both and so let's just ... Haredi for a moment. If the rabbi who is making merchandise of you, and you allow him, and yet they're not taking the Towrah and Prophets from you but they're encouraging you not to read it and to spend all of your time with your nose in the Talmud, but you've got it; you can read it, you can read Howsha'. Open the fourth chapter. See what it says, deal with it. Show some backbone; save yourself, save your family. What's your excuse? Even Christians carry it around, they could read it.

It's so stunning to me how obvious it is that Ezekiel not only is a false prophet. It's not like he occasionally gets a statement wrong (one wrong in the whole book and he's a false prophet), but he also didn't get anything right. It's all wrong. You just can't be 100% wrong by accident. If you toss a coin in the air, yes or no heads or tails, it is not going to land on tails 100 times, yet there's a thousand statements in Ezekiel and every single one is wrong. It's not possible unless it's by intent. So, how in the world can there be religious Jews, Christians and Muslims that read this book and claim it comes from their god when it's all wrong? It's just stunning to me how far people will go to try to justify the most absurd things. And that's what God's saying, "You're just foolish; it's cruel what you've done. I don't want any part of you, but I am telling you that I will hold you accountable."

I have a hunch based upon a number of things that I've translated. There is a fella that was taken to Yahowah, (Yahowah really likes this guy) the only person really taken in this way. I know there's the story about Enoch, but we don't know enough about Enoch to have any clue. But we know a lot about 'ElYah. He's super sarcastic, no respect for religion or politics, hates it and in fact is eminently qualified to tear it to ribbons. 'ElYah is going to judge Jews; he's going to be the guy, and if you want to know the outcome consider what he did to the 850 prophets of the Lord and Asherah. That's what's going to happen; he's going to be the judge and it's going to be fatal. Some will say, "Well, God will be my judge." No, He not.

Why don't you tell me one thing that God did alone? Even in the Creation He uses "we" because He was there with the Ruwach Qodesh, and I think at that time He'd probably also created the *malak*. God doesn't do anything alone. He created the universe for man and the moment man existed He began a relationship with us. He went to liberate the Children of Israel with an 80-year-old man. He saved the people

around where the Garden of Eden was and where civilizations sprouted from there, red in tooth and claw, by working with an old guy to build a boat. When Israel wanted a king and they chose poorly God said, "Listen. I think this is a bad idea. You're rejecting Me but if you're going to have one would you at least (consider?) a shepherd? Let me explain to you what the right choice is." He gave them that example and not only led Yisra'el (at the only time it was really glorious) through a man - Dowd / David. Through all eternity he's bringing Dowd the Messiah and Son of God back to be responsible for leading us through eternity. God never works alone. So, that's something to think about through this entire process because He's going to judge Jews through the man that He feels is the most qualified to do it. That man's going to be "ElYah and he does not take religion lightly; he despises it. To be tried in front of 'ElYah is to be mocked; he's not going to listen to any excuse. It's going to be shameful. He is one my very favorites; I like his sense of humor because I think it reflects intellect and I think God likes to mock religion.

My favorite of the prophets is kind of a toss-up among four guys for different reasons.

I think Moshe is the most marvelous human being that ever lived in terms of his courage and his steadfastness, his devotion to duty, his intellect and the soaring nature of his speeches in *Dabarym*. Herding Jews across the desert for 40 years was no easy task. That guy really had his act together; he was such an impressive guy. Even before he knew Yahowah he stood up for his people and risked his own life to do so only to be embarrassed and shamed by his people for having done so. So, Moshe is really high on my list.

It's very hard for me to overlook Dowd. He's the most exceptional man in human history and probably the most brilliant, certainly the most articulate, the best shepherd and the most passionate about God. He is the one man God says, "He is my Son, I am his Father," the one man that Yahowah anointed three times as Messiah and the one person God is bringing back to lead us through forever more.

I love the humor, intellect and character of 'ElYah / Elisha whom we've talked about.

I feel a special kinship for Yasha'yah / Isaiah. There's so much of Yasha'yah / Isaiah that that speaks of what we're doing together, and his prophetic insights are so rich and so sweeping.

It's wonderful to be part of the same team and the same family as these individuals.

KIRK: I still don't really understand what it is about people that they need to put somebody between them and God. They must feel that they pick out that this is a holy person, and he can go to God and he can somehow be in between God, and obviously now applied it to the modern-day rabbis and I made a list like I used to when we were doing the Paul shows. Rabbis don't teach anyone Yahowah's name (we talked about that forever), they don't what it means, and they don't know how to pronounce it, and if even if they do, they won't repeat it. They bury it and then they change it to Lord, Satan's title. If you knew that alone, you would say, "What the hell am I listening to these people for?" And then they don't teach the five terms and conditions of the Covenant which are paramount to me. When I found that then I said, "Okay. I know what He wants. I can do every one of them. I can deal with this."

YADA: Once you know the five terms and conditions, you are on your own, man, and you can deal directly with Yahowah. He said, "Okay. This is what you want, I'm there man." They are empowering and liberating.

KIRK: In addition, when you go to those five terms and you realize that the Mow'ed Miqra'ey are the pathway home and the teaching implements that allow us to know what these are for and what Yahowah has done and you appreciate Him better. They don't officiate these feasts like they were told to do if they were Lowy.

YADA: They completely ignore Matsah and make Passover the end all and be all, and yet Matsah is vastly more important than Passover. Passover is part of Matsah not the other way around. They have no concept of what Bikuwrym means as the third of the seven Mow'ed Miqra'ey. Very few even mention the exceedingly important day of Shabuw'ah anymore because the Christian Church stole it with their Pentecost. They hate Taruw'ah to the point that they have replaced it with the Babylonian New Year Rosh Hashanah. They've corrupted Kipurym to the point that it's the opposite of what God intended. Rather than a Day of Reconciliations it's a day to abuse oneself, and they are clueless to the fact that Sukah means, "I'm inviting you back to Eden." There's not a rabbi or religious Jew on Earth that has any concept of these things and when you know them, you're totally independent and independence with Yahowah is a good thing. You're not beholden to anybody.

KIRK: Two things further. That led me to think about the law which is obeying rules and it really eliminates free will. So, Yahowah wouldn't do that. Why bother? If you're going to do that then you can't have a relationship. The whole thing falls apart based on changing things from teaching Yahowah's instruction and all that sort of thing. If you're going to have a law, it's going to be obeyed by regulations and be

penalized because of it. You couldn't function that way, it's no relationship that way and they never express those things.

Then that led me to an old Post-It note that says Mizmowr 119:33 "Yahowah (yarah) teach me (derek) the way (choq) the prescriptions for living (wa) and (natsar) I will habitually observe them ('eqeb) and I will benefit until the end of time." That's the antidote to all this stuff, to these people. You don't need these people. For goodness sakes, you can translate this stuff online and get 99% of it if you put a little thought behind it, if you understood the concepts. This is so sad. This is the only place you'll hear it, the only place you'll read it in depth, where you can actually explore it, see what it says compared to what you saw in written in a interlineary and lexicon. I do it every week whether we speak about it or not it makes no difference, it's fun for me.

YADA: Yeah. There's not a single program on this material anywhere, and we have tens of thousands of them. There isn't a single book on this material anywhere that's ever been written and yet we have 26 of them all posted at yadayah.com for you to read for free. They're all published also by Amazon for you to buy just for the cost of printing and shipping. We don't make a royalty on them, we're trying to ... give you everything you could possibly want. We're not sharing our conclusions, we're sharing what Yahowah conveyed. We read and translate His statements as thoroughly, completely and as accurately as possible. We even put the genitive form of the Hebrew word within the parenthetical because if you're reading it online you can copy and paste it into a search engine and verify it yourself. So, even the translations are open for you to verify. If there's something in a translation that is complex, that might have various potential meanings, we'll acknowledge it and we'll tell you this this could mean any one of these different things and this is the reason we've chosen to render these definitions within the translation itself and then we do what Yahowah is encouraging here. It's an exceedingly important thing to know what God said to accurately and completely study the words He has revealed. It is another and far more important thing, then, to make the proper connections between everything He has conveyed so you see the big picture through the details, and that is the reason why there's so many insights and commentary throughout Yada Yahowah. We're trying to help those who are reading this information understand because once you understand then you have a direct relationship with Yahowah. You do not need to rely on anyone, you're completely liberated to benefit from all He is offering, and the wonderful thing is that you get to share it with others who have come to know Him and be part of the Covenant family but yet you are also

independent of everyone, not dependent upon anyone except Yahowah Himself. So, it is all here; we gain nothing from you choosing to accept and know Yahowah, to attend His Mow'ed Migra'ey, to accept the terms and condition of His Covenant. There's no dime in this for us. I've been doing this now for 22 years I've never been paid by anyone, never received a donation from anyone and I actually pay for the privileges as Dee knows because she manages our social media outreach that I pay for. It's actually seven dimensional so it's infinitely beyond our imagination. It's not just the 400 billion galaxies each averaging some several hundred billion stars apiece of the known universe, and that's only four percent of the known universe because 96 exceeds our ability to even understand what it is in terms of dark energy and dark matter which I think are dimensions. But as you're liberated in time in the fourth dimension the universe expands infinitely beyond what we can see, and you can enjoy the entire universe when you're liberated in time. And there's two dimensions beyond that en route to Yahowah, Who is seven dimensional.

What we're being offered is so enormous that having more people makes it more fun. But it's not just that. When you come to be part of Yahowah's family and know Him then we have this tendency to want what He wants – He's Dad; He's really nice to us so we want to be involved in the family business. The family business is conveying His message and inviting people to become part of the Covenant family. You want to be part of it. Those who are part of the family business passionately, accurately and completely share the words of Yahowah and then seek to understand them so that we can share and pass on that understanding and the insights to others.

The second thing is it's so empowering, enriching, uplifting and emancipating to be with Yahowah; we don't want to covet that, we want to share it. It's like seeing a beautiful rainbow across a streaked sky over the ocean. To see it alone is one thing, but it's much more beautiful to share it with someone. A couple nights ago I was out in the evening, my wife had a rough day and she turned in early, and I saw the full moon ducking in and out of the clouds, glistening within their silver linings. And then the most magnificent meteor that I've ever seen in terms of the brightest and the longest trail streaked across the sky and my only regret was that I was viewing it alone. So, we naturally want to share. Yahowah is wonderful, He's approachable He's fun to be around and so we're doing this because we are so blessed and so benefited from this, and we just want others to know about it.

Part of it too is we share Yahowah's antagonism towards religion and politics and we recognize that it takes courage, but it's the right thing to do it's. It's in a very big way it's like what we talk about often. If you were to walk by a group of people that are holding down and raping a child. Are you going to be one of those that just walk by, are you going to be one of those that films it, are you going to be one of those that might sneak away to call the police or you're going to be one that tries to help and defend that child? Who are you? With Yahowah religion is raping world and robbing children of their dignity and their lives. Politics is doing the same thing. So, are you just going to stand by, walk past, or stop it? Character counts.

Moseh saw the religious, political and economic establishment of Egypt beating one of his own to death and he stood in the way. He had the courage and the character to stand up for the man that was being beaten. That's what makes Moseh so extraordinary and then when he realized how awful the Egyptian religion and government was, he left Egypt. That's what made him useful to God. Are you willing to do that? I guess the first thing is you would have to recognize that that's why we speak about these things and why God speaks about them. Religion leads you in the wrong direction. First, you'd have to question your religion and politics and leave them. Until you do so you have zero chance of coming to know Yahowah or engaging in a relationship with Him.

Look at 'Abraham. He wasn't the nicest guy on the planet but 'Abraham did something that almost no one else was willing to do; he walked away from Ur which was Sumer in what became Babylon. He walked away from the most religious and political place on Earth. After he walked away Yahowah could engage with him and introduce Himself to him.

Look at Moseh. God didn't call Moshe when he was in Egypt under the influence of religion and politics, He waited until after Moshe had left it.

He didn't find Dowd as a leading figure in a Yeshiva in Israel or under Saul's command leading a charge or as a priest or as a religious nut. No. He found him out tending sheep; he was the only son that was nowhere to be found when the others were auditioned. He was out in Bethlehem tending sheep.

Until we walk away from religion and politics God's unknowable to us, and that's why God spends so much time, as He's doing through the book of Howsha', calling His people away from theism and from Israeli politics. It's only once you walk away from them and you know they're rotten to the core that you have a chance to come to know God.

Israel is right now in a very precarious place. About half of Israel despises Benjamin Netanyahu, about half likes him. For Benjamin Netanyahu to prevail under those circumstances he had to put together a coalition of extreme religious zealots and the kinds of things that they're trying to do now in terms of immigration into Israel based on religious qualifications, divorce in Israel where only the man can grant it under rabbinic law, judicial reform where convicted crooks and criminals can hold ministerial positions, the kinds of things they are trying to do are so outrageous that the 50% of Israelis that can't stand Benjamin Netanyahu are taking to the streets and the former coalition members in the past government, which was also a government from Hell, are now encouraging people to be riotous in the street, and then Netanyahu's coalition is saying they ought to arrest the opposition leaders. It's becoming a very dangerous thing, they are even talking about civil war, and with Muslims surrounding them wanting to obliterate them when Israel is doing what it does best, which is infighting and sacrificing their own, this is a very scary time. I'm here to tell you that if you are a Jew and if you are listening at this point, chances are you're listing either to an archive or you're on the phone because we're no longer broadcasting, if you are listening and you're in Israel tonight and I would strongly encourage you to devote considerable time to reading Yada Yahowah.

Start with An Introduction to God, Volume 1, Dabarym. In Chapter 3, Why You, Why Me? You will come to understand why God is speaking to you and why He is speaking through me. This chapter is an essential part of understanding who Yahowah is and what He is offering and expecting in return. For the many Jews who have been indoctrinated to believe that if it's not a Jew speaking to you don't listen, one of the things you need to understand is that the Jews stop listening to Yahowah.
